UPPSALA DECLARATION 2010

Conscious of the imminent threats to our planet caused by unsustainable production and consumption patterns that compromise the options of current and future generations and the sustainability of life on earth, 29 delegates representing 12 international and national networks of schools have met for a workshop in Uppsala, Sweden, initiated by the Life-Link Friendship-Schools Programme and hosted by the Dag Hammarskjöld Foundation.

The workshop was also a response to the Call for Action expressed within the 2009 Bonn Declaration, formulated at the World Conference on Education for Sustainable Development.

The workshop, for the first time ever, brings together networks of schools to promote actions worldwide.

In view of the urgent need for initiating concrete programmes aimed at education that empowers people to acquire values, knowledge, skills and competencies for sustainable living, the Earth Care Campaign 2010-2014 for the first time ever brings three concrete actions to schools worldwide:

- *Water for Life*
- *Culture of Care*
- *RRR Reduce-Reuse-Recycle*

The Uppsala Workshop 2010 delegates invite any network of schools or any individual school that complies with the ethics of ESD and Water for Life Decades to join.
